Women's Dermatologic Society Launched National Sun Safety Program in 15 Cities thanks to \$1,000,000 grant from 3M Corporation.

In response to the dire need to curb the U.S. epidemic of skin cancer, the Women's Dermatologic Society (WDS) has launched a broad-based national campaign to promote sun safety in underserved communities, made possible by a \$1 million grant recently awarded by the 3M Foundation. The campaign, "Families Play Safe in the Sun" provides skin health awareness and education to families and students in fifteen

targeted U.S. cities, utilizing a volunteer cadre of 1,200 WDS member dermatologists based in cities across the nation. This community service program mobilizes the national group's dermatologist members to reach out into the communities in which they live and work in a concerted effort to help prevent skin cancer and promote sun safety in diverse populations.
